### Class 1 Prelim 10 (2006) short arena

Combination of horse/pony and rider not to have won more than two dressage tests within the last 3 years and/or horse/pony not to have more than 15 dressage points\*.

***This class is not a qualifier for the Championship class.***

### Class 2 Prelim 17 (2002) long arena – CHAMPIONSHIP CLASS

*Open to all, only those that have qualified for the championship are eligible to compete for Champion & Reserve Champion prizes.*

Combination of horse/pony and rider not to have won more than two dressage tests within the last 3 years and/or horse/pony not to have more than 15 dressage points\*.

### Class 3 Novice 30 (2006) short arena

Horse/pony not to have more than 75 dressage points\*.

***This class is not a qualifier for the Championship class.***

### Class 4 Novice 38 (2005) long arena – CHAMPIONSHIP CLASS

*Open to all, only those that have qualified for the championship are eligible to compete for Champion & Reserve Champion prizes.*

Horse/pony not to have more than 75 dressage points\*.

### Class 5 Elementary 41 (2002) short arena

No restrictions.

***This class is not a qualifier for the Championship class.***

### Class 6 Elementary 58 (2004), Med 74 (2002) long arena – CHAMPIONSHIP CLASS

*Open to all, only those that have qualified for the championship are eligible to compete for Champion & Reserve Champion prizes.*

No restrictions. All tests will be judged within the same class. Placings are on overall percentage regardless of test ridden. Competitors can ride two different tests on the same horse. Please advise on entry form which test you wish to ride.

**NO TESTS MAY BE COMMANDED AND NO WHIPS MAY BE CARRIED IN CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES (CLASSES 2, 4, & 6)**

**PLEASE NOTE: THERE WILL BE A MOUNTED PRESENTATION FOR CHAMPION AND RESERVE IN CLASSES 2, 4 & 6**

**ENTRIES:** Close Tuesday 15 August. Late entries £2 extra if space available. Cheques made payable to Saffron Walden & District Riding Club.

**ENTRY FEES:** SWDRC member £6, non SWDRC member £8.

**MAKING AN ENTRY:** If an official entry form is unavailable, please supply in capital letters the date of the competition, class(es) entered, name of rider, age of rider (if under 18), name and height of horse/pony, contact telephone number, name and address. By placing an entry you automatically agree to abide by the rules of the competition and the Club. Please include a cheque made payable to Saffron Walden & District Riding Club (please do not send cash).

**PRIZES:** Rosettes to 6th place in all classes. Members rosette to highest placed SWDRC member in each class. Classes 2, 4 & 6 – Baileys Sash and Champion rosette to highest placed competitor who has qualified for the championships and & Baileys Reserve Champion rosette to second highest placed competitor who has qualified for the championships.

**COPIES OF DRESSAGE TESTS:** Dressage tests can be obtained from the BHS Bookshop, Stoneleigh Deer Park, Kenilworth, Warwickshire CV8 2XZ. Please send an SAE together with a list of test(s) required and loose stamps to the value of 40p for each test, up to a total of 4. If order for tests is over £2.50, please send a cheque and SAE or from [www.dressagediagrams.com](http://www.dressagediagrams.com) with the exception of the Walk/Trot test which can be found on [www.swdrc.co.uk](http://www.swdrc.co.uk) or copies can be obtained from the secretary.

**DRESSAGE SERIES POINTS TROPHY:** A members points system will operate throughout the year. A junior and senior trophy is awarded at the AGM to the horse/pony and rider combination with the most accumulative points over the series. Points are only awarded once membership has been paid and are awarded according to percentage totals.

**VENUE DIRECTIONS:** Sparrows Hill Livery is situated on the B1052. Close to the B1052/B1383 junction.

**NOTE:** Competition arena outdoor surfaces 20m x 40m and 20m x 60m. Some short arena tests may be ridden in the long arena with boards to shorten to a 20m x 40m. Warm up area on grass. There may be no catering facilities at this event.

**RULES:** Please see full rules before making an entry as receipt of entry means that the entrant agrees to abide by the rules of the Saffron Walden and District Riding Club.

- At all Saffron Walden & District Riding Club (SWDRC) events all competitors must wear a crash hat when mounted with chin straps fastened to comply with BSEN 4472/6473 or BSEN 1384 or PAS 015 (which are recommended by the British Riding Clubs). **FAILURE TO COMPLY INCURS IMMEDIATE ELIMINATION.**
- In case of bad weather conditions please either call the secretary or tel 07919 312041 for an event update.
- \*Dressage Rule: "Downgraded Horses" - For every full year that a horse with affiliated dressage points remains unregistered, 12 points may be deducted when calculating eligibility for competitions.
- British dressage rules apply to all dressage events unless otherwise stated in the rules.
