Class 1 Novice Combined Training

Dressage: Prelim 4 (2002) short

Show Jumping: approx height 69cm - 76cm (2'3" - 2'6")

Combination of horse/pony and rider never to have been placed in a combined training or ODE competition

Entry fees: SWDRC member £8, non SWDRC member £10

Class 2 Advanced Novice Combined Training

Dressage: Elementary 41 (2002) short

Show Jumping: approx height 85cm - 90cm (2'3" - 2'6")

No restrictions

Entry fees: SWDRC member £8, non SWDRC member £10

Class 3 Intermediate Combined Training

Dressage: Novice 21 (2002) short

Show Jumping: approx height 76cm - 85cm (2'6" - 2'9")

Combination of horse/pony and rider never to have won a combined training or ODE competition

Entry fees: SWDRC member £8, non SWDRC member £10

Class 4 Open Combined Training

Dressage: Novice 36 (2002) short

Show Jumping: approx height 85cm - 90cm (2'9" - 3'0")

No restrictions

Entry fees: SWDRC member £8, non SWDRC member £10

Dressage tests to be ridden in an outdoor ménage. Show jumping will take place on grass surface.

MAKING AN ENTRY: If an official entry form is unavailable, please supply in capital letters the date of the competition, class(es) entered, name of rider, age of rider (if under 18), name and height of horse/pony, contact telephone number, name and address. By placing an entry you automatically agree to abide by the rules of the competition and the Club. Please include a cheque made payable to Saffron Walden & District Riding Club (please do not send cash).

PRIZES: Rosettes to 6th place in all classes. Members rosette to highest placed SWDRC member in each class.

COPIES OF DRESSAGE TESTS: Dressage tests can be obtained from British Dressage or www.dressagediagrams.com.

VENUE DIRECTIONS: Sparrows Hill Livery is situated on the B1052. Close to the B1052/B1383 junction.

NOTE: Dressage arena outdoor surfaces 20m x 40m or 20m x 60m. Warm up for dressage on grass. Show jumping warm up and course on grass. There may be no catering facilities at this event.

RULES: Please see full rules before making an entry as receipt of entry means that the entrant agrees to abide by the rules of the Saffron Walden and District Riding Club.

- At all Saffron Walden & District Riding Club (SWDRC) events all competitors must wear a crash hat when mounted with chin straps fastened to comply with BSEN 4472/6473 or BSEN 1384 or PAS 015 (which are recommended by the British Riding Clubs). **FAILURE TO COMPLY INCURS IMMEDIATE ELIMINATION.**
- In case of bad weather conditions please either call the secretary or tel 07919 312041 for an event update.
- Dressage Rule: "Downgraded Horses" - For every full year that a horse with affiliated dressage points remains unregistered, 12 points may be deducted when calculating eligibility for competitions.
- British dressage rules apply to all dressage events unless otherwise stated in the rules.
