Nick is particularly safety conscious and has a number of ideas to help educate both horse and rider to give them both confidence at all levels.

Jumping club nights with Nick cost only £12.50 per rider, as they are subsidised by the riding club (£20.00 for non-members). Sessions are 1 hour long, with 4 riders per session, (or 45 mins with 3 riders).

Please state on your entry if you can't make a particular time, however if you are flexible it is easier to get you in and in the best-matched group.
