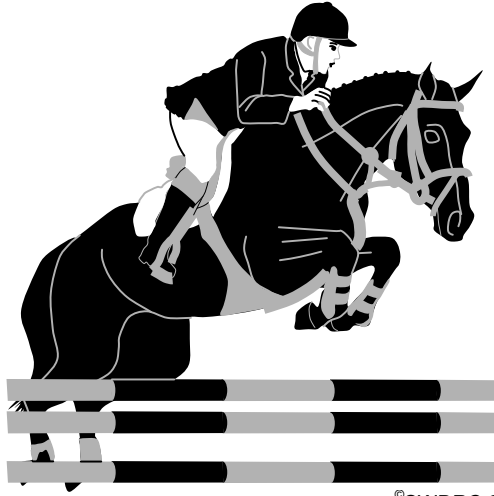

SHOW JUMPING

SUNDAY 16 MARCH 2008

GREEN FARM STUD, LOWER GREEN, STOKE-BY-CLARE, CO10 8HP

- Class 1 Clear Round** 60cm approx (2'3") Rosettes to all clear rounds
(10.00am) **Entries will be strictly limited and no entries on the day (if space) will be taken after 10.30am**
Entry fees: SWDRC member £3, non SWDRC member £5
- Class 2 Novice** First round 69cm approx (2'3"). Jump off 76cm approx (2'6")
(11.00am) Combination of horse/pony and rider not to have won more than two show jumping competitions of novice standard or above.
Entry fees: SWDRC member £4, non SWDRC member £6
- Class 3 Intermediate** First round 76cm approx (2'6"). Jump off 85cm approx (2'9")
(12.00pm) Combination of horse/pony and rider not to have won more than two show jumping competitions of intermediate standard or above.
Entry fees: SWDRC member £4, non SWDRC member £6
- Class 4 Small Open** First round 85cm approx (2'9"). Jump off 90cm approx (3'0")
(1.00pm) No restrictions.
Entry fees: SWDRC member £4, non SWDRC member £6
- Class 5 Open** First round 90cm approx (3'0"). Jump off 100cm approx (3'3")
(1.30pm) No restrictions.
Entry fees: SWDRC member £4, non SWDRC member £6

(classes will not commence before times stated)

Where entries permit - results will be split horse/pony

Entries close on the Friday prior to the event.

Entries on the day accepted if space available. Late entries £2 extra or £3 once the class has started.

Parking may be tight, please park thoughtfully.

ENTRIES: Close on the Friday prior to the event. Late entries £2 extra or £3 once the class has started. Entries on the day if numbers permit. Cheques made payable to: Saffron Walden & District Riding Club. By placing an entry you automatically agree to abide by the rules of the competition and the Club.

PRIZES: Where entries permit - results will be split horse/pony. Rosettes to 6th place in all classes. Members rosette to highest placed SWDRC member in each class. First to sixth from classes 2-5 qualify for the Show Jumping Championship on Saturday 23 August 2008. Where classes are split horse/pony qualification will be gained from both results.

SHOW JUMPING POINTS SYSTEM: A points system will operate throughout the year with a points trophy being awarded at the AGM to the junior and senior SWDRC member and horse/pony combination with the most points at the end of the season. Points are only awarded once membership has been paid. Where classes are split horse/pony points will be awarded for both results.

VENUE DIRECTIONS: Green Farm Stud is located on the north side of the A1092 through Stoke-by-Clare. Venue will be signposted from the A1092.

NOTE: Competition will be run either indoors in a 20m x 60m arena or outdoors on a 35m x 60m surface. In the event of wet weather please check www.swdrc.co.uk for an event update. There may be no catering, toilet or first aid facilities at this event. **Competitors must take all their muck and rubbish home with them. PARKING MAY BE TIGHT, PLEASE PARK THOUGHTFULLY.**

RULES: Please see full rules before making an entry as receipt of entry means that the entrant agrees to abide by the rules of the Saffron Walden and District Riding Club.

- At all Saffron Walden & District Riding Club (SWDRC) events all competitors must wear a crash hat when mounted with chin straps fastened to comply with BSEN 4472/6473 or BSEN 1384 or PAS 015 (which are recommended by the British Riding Clubs). **FAILURE TO COMPLY INCURS IMMEDIATE ELIMINATION.**
- In case of bad weather conditions please either call the secretary or tel: 07919 312041 for an event update.
- Combinations of horse/pony and rider may compete in no more than two classes at any one competition (excluding clear round classes). Please note that the classes must be consecutive classes. Horses/ponies may only compete once in any one class. This rule also applies to the Championships – if a combination has qualified for more than two championship classes, the combination may only compete in two consecutive championship classes. – if a horse/pony has qualified for any championship class with more than one rider, then only one rider may compete in the championship class. See rule 2.
- BRC rules apply to all show jumping events unless otherwise stated in the rules.
