Class 1 Prelim 13 (2006) short arena

Combination of horse/pony and rider not to have won a dressage test within the last 3 years and/or horse/pony not to have more than 25 dressage points*

This class is a qualifier for the Championships on 19 September 2010

Class 2 Novice 30 (2006) short arena

Horse/pony not to have more than 124 dressage points*

This class is a qualifier for the Championships on 19 September 2010

Please note that due to only one competition arena, we are limited in the number of entrants we can accept

To avoid disappointment, please enter early

Entries will be taken on a first-come, first-served basis, with priority given to SWDRC members

Hors Concours entries may be taken if space allows

ENTRIES: Close Tuesday 26 January. Late entries £2 extra if space available. Cheques made payable to SWDRC.

ENTRY FEES: SWDRC member £6.50, non SWDRC member £10.00.

PRIZES: Rosettes to 6th place in all classes. First to sixth from classes 1 & 2 qualify for the Dressage Championship on Sunday 19 September 2010.

DRESSAGE SERIES POINTS TROPHY: A members points system will operate throughout the year. A junior and senior trophy is awarded at the AGM to the horse/pony and rider combination with the most accumulative points over the series. Points are only awarded once membership has been paid.

VENUE DIRECTIONS: Brook Farm Equestrian Centre is situated on the B1054. On the way out of Radwinter heading towards Hempstead.

NOTE: Competition arena indoor 20m x 40m. Warm up area 20m x 40m outdoor surface. There may be no catering, toilet or first aid facilities at this event. **Competitors must take all their muck and rubbish home with them. PARKING CAN BE TIGHT, PLEASE PARK THOUGHTFULLY.**

RULES: Please see full rules before making an entry as receipt of entry means that the entrant agrees to abide by the rules of the Saffron Walden and District Riding Club.

1. At all Saffron Walden & District Riding Club (SWDRC) events all competitors must wear a crash hat when mounted with chin straps fastened to comply with BSEN 4472/6473 or BSEN 1384 or PAS 015 (which are recommended by the British Riding Clubs). **FAILURE TO COMPLY INCURS IMMEDIATE ELIMINATION.**

15. In case of bad weather conditions please either call the secretary for an event update.

16. *Dressage Rule: "Downgraded Horses" - For every full year that a horse with affiliated dressage points remains unregistered, 12 points may be deducted when calculating eligibility for competitions.

17. British dressage rules apply to all dressage events unless otherwise stated in the rules.
